A Guide to Event Intercession

Determine the focus of your prayers and with whom you will share any discernment you receive.

Your Prayer Assignment:

- Will you pray for the whole event or just a part?
- Will you pray for all participants or specific people (leaders, attendees, worship team)?

Intercession Models:

- **Off-Site Intercession:** Pray at home or church. Benefits include fewer distractions and private, creative prayer.
- **On-Site Intercession:** Pray during the event. Benefits include real-time discernment and immediate prayer response.
- **Combined Strategy:** Mix of on-site and off-site intercession for comprehensive coverage.

Preparation for the Event:

- **Personal Spiritual Preparation:** Spend time with God, confess sins, and put on the full armor of God.
- **Interfacing with Leadership:** Event leaders often request the presence of a prayer team. Keep in touch with them to receive their vision and prayer requests.

Event Intercession:

- **Purpose and Focus:** Know the goals of the event and your responsibilities.
- **Interfacing with Leadership:** Communicate with event leaders before, during, and after the event.
- **Sharing Discernment:** Share insights with humility and let leadership decide on action.

Recruiting Your Prayer Team:

- **Selection:** Choose experienced members and those with a heart for prayer.
- **Enlisting Support:** Find people to pray for the event and your team.
- **Logistical Preparation:** Have a clear plan for the prayer team and prepare guidelines.
- **Praying Ahead:** Pray for the event, participants, and team members. Do a prayer walk through the event space.
